Categories

Mixed team of 4 (at least 1 female bowler in the team)

Singles – Men's

Singles – Women's

The maximum number of Teams will be 18.

Register early to secure your team's spot.

General Rules

1. This is a scratch tournament (*i.e.*, **no handicaps**) open to all eligible bowlers.
2. The bowling centre will open at 9AM, and games will commence at 9:30AM.
3. Bowlers/Teams must check in 15 minutes prior to the advertised time for Teams Event and the Singles Event.
4. Dress Code – appropriate bowling attire to be worn, dress shorts for men and mid-thigh length shorts for women are permitted. Jeans, tights or track pants are NOT acceptable. All bowlers must be wearing their Team uniforms during the games.
5. Bowlers who are absent will receive a score of 0 for each frame that he/she has missed.

6. Draw for the lane assignments will be distributed near the tournament date.
7. Where a rule is not stated, the Bowling tournament committee will make the decision.

Team Event Rules

1. Each team should have no more than four (4) bowlers and **MUST** have at least 1 female bowler.
2. Each bowler will play six (6) games. No substitution of player(s) will be allowed once the games have commenced.
3. The team score is the total of the scratch scores of each member of the team.
4. In case of a tie, a 2-frame roll-off will be used to break the deadlock. If there is still tie after the 2-frame roll-off, another frame will be bowled.

Singles Event

1. The result of the individual performances in the Team event will determine the participants of the singles event.
2. The top 15 male and 9 female bowlers with the highest 6-game series will advance to the singles event.
3. In the event of a tie for a slot in the singles event, the bowler with the highest game score in the team event will advance to the singles event.
4. If there is still a tie after rule 2 above, a two frame roll-off will be played between the bowlers involved. A two frame roll-off is like playing the 9th and 10th frame of a game. The bowler with the highest score after the two frame roll-off will be declared the winner of the tie.
5. The Single Event scores will start from zero (0). No carry over from the Teams Event.
6. **Each bowler will play 6 games in the singles event.**
7. Bowlers will play 3 blocks of 2 games on lanes as dictated by the positions of the bowlers in the team event.
8. The top three bowlers on each division – male and female – will be adjudged the winners of the singles event. 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers.
9. In the event of a tie for the top three scores, a two frame roll-off will determine the winner of the tie.

Awards

The following awards will be given as well:

1. The **CHAMPION SHIELD** will be given to the over-all winner of Tenpin Bowling team event.
2. Team trophy for the Champion team, plus individual medals for the team members.
3. Individual Medals will be given to the First Runner-Up and Second Runner-Up of the team event.
4. Trophies for the top 3 in the Singles' Event for both Male and Female categories.
5. Trophies for the Male and Female High Games.
6. Trophies for Singles High Series scores from the Teams games, Men's and Women's Division.
7. Trophies for Junior Under 16 High Game – male and female

Waiver

Each player must read and agree to the waiver below.

I declare that:

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. If any 'act of God' conditions cause a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.
3. I am in a proper physical condition to take part in the Event, given the known parameters of the Event (such as the length, time, physical demands and environmental context).
