General Information and Rules

The golf tournament will be 2 rounds of golf over 2 days, Saturday and Sunday.

- 24 Oct Saturday 1pm to 7pm, Shandon GC, 471 Jackson Street, Petone, Lower Hutt
- 25 Oct Sunday 10am to 5pm, Manor Park GC, 32 Golf Road, Manor Park, Lower Hutt

Registration and fees

- The tournament will be limited to the first 48 registrations.
- Each player will need to register individually. For the team's event, the team composition is not required at registration, but needs to be submitted to the golf organisers before the start of the first round
- **The registration fee will be \$20.** This registration fee does **NOT** include the green fees. **EACH** player will pay their OWN green fees at the PRO shop and PRINT their own scorecards from the club's official printer. Green fees Shandon \$60, Manor Park \$45
- Members and reciprocal club members may not need to pay green fees, subject to PRO shop approval.
- On the registration form, the following details need to be supplied:
 - Name
 - Affiliated federation (e.g. PGC–Auckland, WFSA-Golf-Wellington, etc.)
 - Home golf club (e.g. Manor Park, Redwood Park, etc)
 - NZGA member ID
 - NZGA handicap index

Tournament format:

Strokeplay, with 2 concurrent events (player's daily scores count towards both events)

- **Teams** event: (4 players per team), total of all team members' individual stableford points over 2 rounds count towards the team total. A city can have more than one 4-member teams as they can field.
- **Individual** events for best net and best stableford scores over 2 rounds

Ties will be broken via countback as follows:

1. Better 2nd round score
2. Better back-9 score, then front-9 (using 2nd round, then 1st round scores)

3. Better 18th hole, then 17th, 16th, etc (using 2nd round, then 1st round scores) and so on until the tie is broken
4. If still a tie, via coin toss.

If the tournament is reduced to a single round tournament (e.g. either round is cancelled due to weather), the scores for the completed round will be used to determine the winners.

Handicaps

The player's OFFICIAL NZGA handicap index on the day of the competition will be used. When scorecards are printed on the day, the player's course handicap is automatically calculated/printed by the NZGA DOT golf system.

Players without official NZGA handicaps will be allowed to play, but cannot participate in the strokeplay individual and team events (casual/social playing only, qualifying only to the daily novelty prizes).

Prizegiving/Prizes:

The prize giving will be held shortly after the completion of the 2nd round (ETA Manor Park GC, approximately 3.30pm)

Teams event:

- Champion: 4 individual gold medals, 1 sleeve of golf balls each player
- 1st runner-up: 4 individual silver medals
- 2nd runner-up: 4 individual bronze medals

Individual events:

Best Net total 2 rounds

- Champion: gold medal and 1 sleeve of golf balls
- 1st runner-up: silver medal
- 2nd runner-up: bronze medal

Best Stableford total 2 rounds

- Champion: gold medal and 1 sleeve of golf balls
- 1st runner-up: silver medal
- 2nd runner-up: bronze medal

Daily prizes:

- Best Nett - 1 sleeve of golf balls
- Best Stableford - 1 sleeve of golf balls
- Nearest to the pin, 3 holes per day, 1 sleeve of golf balls per hole

All games must comply with the Rules of Golf as posted on the official website of the Rules of Golf

Local course rules must also be observed

Scorecards must be signed and submitted after the round. Any unsigned or incorrect cards may result in disqualification.

Waiver

Each player must read and agree to the waiver below.

I declare that:

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. If any 'act of God' conditions cause a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.
3. I am in a proper physical condition to take part in the Event, given the known parameters of the Event (such as the length, time, physical demands and environmental context).
4. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing medical conditions and confirm that it is medically safe for me to take part in the Event.
5. I acknowledge that there are risks involved in the Event. I fully realise the dangers of taking part in the Event, and fully assume the risks associated with my participation and my wellbeing and safety during and after the Event. I understand and acknowledge that the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers) provide no warranties, about my wellbeing and safety.
6. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the Event, which may be beyond the immediate control of the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers).
7. I will take part in the Event, in a manner that does not endanger either me or others.
8. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers), the sponsors and other parties associated with the Event, have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the Event.
9. I authorise the use of my name, voice, picture and information on this entry form in any broadcast, telecast, promotion, advertising, and in any other way, without payment to me or any other form of compensation.
10. I agree to follow the rules and regulations about the Event.
11. I agree to follow all reasonable safety instructions provided to me by the Event organisers, (including all officials and event volunteers) before, during and after the Event.
12. I consent to receiving medical treatment if illness or injuries are suffered during or at any time after the Event.
